什麼時候使用**Jext**?

過敏性休克的徵狀可以在數秒、數分鐘或數小 時內出現。當患者接觸致敏原後,如出現以下 徵狀,應立即使用Jext®並致電999報警求助, 並說明自己出現過敏性反應的徵狀。

- 喉嚨收窄、聲沙
- 嘴唇、咽喉、舌頭、手腳腫脹
- 眼、面部麻痺及腫脹
- 呼吸困難、咳嗽、氣喘、聲音嘶啞
- 脈搏微弱、頭暈或失去知覺
- 皮膚瘙癢、凸起紅疹 (類似蕁麻疹)
- 瀕死的感覺、失去意識
- 嘔吐、肚瀉、抽筋、噁心、胃痙攣

除此以外,患者亦可能有以下病徵:

- 口腔內有金屬的味道或麻痺
- 心跳加速
- 血壓急降(這情況下患者的面色會變得蒼白)

什麼是過敏性休克(Anaphylaxis)?

過敏性休克是一種**速發型及嚴重的全身過敏反應**,有 機會致命。發病時間由接觸致敏原數秒至數分鐘後出 現,甚至以小時計。嚴重的過敏反應會引致過敏性休 克,導致血壓急速下降,引起暈眩的感覺,甚至會令 患者失去知覺,以及呼吸困難的情況。

When to use **Jext**?

Anaphylaxis can be accompanied by symptoms that develop rapidly within minutes, or over a period of hours. When you come into contact with an allergen, treatment should be given immediately if any of the following symptoms occur. If you experience any or all of these symptoms, it is time to use Jext® and call 999, ask for an ambulance and say 'anaphylaxis'.

- Tightening of the throat, hoarseness
- Swelling of the lips, throat, tongue and limbs
- Tingling and swelling of eyes and face
- Shortness of breath, cough, wheeze
- Weak pulse, lightheadedness or unconsciousness
- Itchy rash
- Sense of impending doom
- Vomiting, diarrhoea, cramps

People suffering from anaphylaxis may also notice:

- A metallic taste or itching in the mouth
- Faster heart rate
- Rapidly decreasing blood pressure (in this case they are likely to go pale)

Precautions: All patients who are prescribed Jext should be thoroughly instructed to understand the indications for use and the correct method of administration. Caution is indicated in patients receiving drugs that may sensitise the heart to arrhythmias, including digitalis and quinidine. The effects of adrenaline may be potentiated by tricyclic antidepressants, monoamine oxidase inhibitors (MAO-inhibitors) and catechol-O-methyl transferase inhibitors (COMT inhibitors). Adrenaline should be used in pregnancy only if the potential benefit justifies any potential risk to the foetus.

Adverse events: May include palpitations, tachycardia, nausea and vomiting, respiratory difficulty, headache, dizziness and anxiety. Cardiac arrhythmias may follow administration adrenaline. Overdoses of adrenaline may cause cerebral haemorrhage or arrhythmias.

What is anaphylaxis?

Anaphylaxis is a severe and potentially fatal allergic reaction. It may start suddenly within seconds or minutes, or take a few hours to develop following contact with an allergen which is a substance that is capable of producing an allergic reaction.

A severe anaphylactic reaction is sometimes known as anaphylactic shock. Anaphylaxis can cause the blood pressure to drop quickly, resulting in fainting or even sustained loss of consciousness. It can also cause severe breathing difficulties.

Medicine – most commonly antibiotics (e.g. penicillin), aspirin or NSAID_s (e.g. ibuprofen)

What is **Jext**?

Jext[®] is a single-use adrenaline auto-injector. Each Jext[®] injects a premeasured single dose of adrenaline for the emergency treatment of anaphylaxis. The needle is contained within the Jext[®] before use and is automatically covered by the black needle shield after use. Jext[®] has been designed to be simple and reliable.

Adrenaline acts to counteract low blood pressure, which can cause dizziness and loss of consciousness in anaphylaxis. It also relaxes airway smooth muscle and reduces throat swelling to improve breathing.


How to use **Jext**?



Pull off the yellow cap.



Push the black tip firmly into your outer thigh until you hear a "click" confirming the injection has started, then keep it pushed in. Hold the injector firmly in place against the thigh for 10 seconds (a slow count to 10) then remove. The black tip will extend automatically and hide the needle.



Massage the injection area for 10 seconds.
